Allied Health Assistant (AHA)

The Allied Health Assistant works under the supervision of the allied health professional, physiotherapist or occupational therapist – to support the treatment goals of the community member.

The Allied Health Assistant may work with a community member to implement an aquatic physiotherapy program, provide muscle stretches, or even provide support to increase independence in activities of daily living.

The Allied Health Assistant is not relevant for all cases and your physiotherapist or occupational therapist can discuss the benefits for you. One of the advantages of using an Allied Health Assistant to implement programs in this way is that the lower price helps to extend the NDIS Plan and provide value for money.
